Veterans (including Masters) 3.30pm (5km)
Junior Men 3.30pm (5km)
Ladies and Junior Ladies 3.30pm (5km)
Paddling Challenge (Senior Men) 4.30pm (10km)

Times for starting may vary, in particular the Junior Men, Ladies and Juniors Ladies could be started as separate events depending on entries.

Prize Giving: After the Paddling Challenge.

Classes: Veterans should be 35 years or older on 1st January 2008.
Masters should be over 50 on the 1st January 2008
Juniors should be under 18 on the 1st January 2008

Entries : £5 Seniors/Masters £4 for Juniors and £3 for Lightnings
Payment on the day but see sheet 2 and get your entry in early if possible
