

Richmond Canoe Club Tours 2008
Chichester Harbour Sunday 27 July

Chichester Harbour time again - the tour for those who don't do tours (and for those who do)! Weather and tides permitting, we will be heading off to sea breezes and gently rolling waves, with possibly some sun bathing and sand castles thrown in.

Chichester Harbour is a large enclosed tidal area with three fingers of water reaching deep inland. A successful trip depends on good weather and not too much wind. If the weather isn't good enough we will have an alternative trip planned that we can do instead.

It is about a 70 mile drive, so we will be starting earlier than other trips, meeting at 7am at the club and return by about 7pm. As usual, we will pool transport and make a charge of £10 (juniors £5) towards the cost of petrol, parking, harbour licences etc. Further information on the trip will be circulated nearer the time.

Just to remind you, the tour group aims to explore new stretches of water, and different paddling challenges, with picnics, pub lunches, and cream teas. The group is open to everyone, but if you are new to the club you may want to check with Peter Barnes, Sarah or Ulrik that the paddle won't be too challenging.
