Buoyancy aids are compulsory for all Div 7, 8, 9 and Lightning paddlers whether in singles or doubles and for all competitors under the age of 16.

As the race will take place on the River Thames, other craft will be encountered and the Rules of the river – and those outlined at the briefing - must be observed.

The River Thames at Richmond is TIDAL and as such is subject to different flow conditions. Rainfall will also affect the character of the water conditions and flow rate.
