The Frank Luzmore Memorial K2 Race

Richmond Canoe Club was originally the idea of Frank Luzmore, a clerk at Toughts boat yard, Teddington. He was a prolific paddler, especially in touring canadian canoes. His exploits included sea trips in decked-in touring canadians. In 1941 he put the idea of a canoe club at Richmond to John Dudderidge, a competitor at the 1936 Olympics, and British Canoe Union secretary. Due to the war, nothing much happened until October 1944, when a meeting was held at the Three Pigeons Pub to start a new canoe club. It was resolved to "Lay the foundation for a club which will foster and encourage the interest of canoeists in the London area."
